___ **360 Search:**

Use 360 Search to find a book of your choice in the Libraries Of Middlesex Automation Consortium Catalog. Print out the catalog page or show it to your teacher for verification.

___ **America's Newspapers:**

Print an article from a newspaper, which is published on a different continent than which you live or show it to your teacher for verification.

___ **Custom Newspapers:**

Search for the topic of your choice and translate an article on that topic into a language other than what you speak. Print the translated page or show it to your teacher for verification.

___ **Encyclopedia Britannica:**

Using World Data Analyst, create a chart comparing the populations of 5 different countries. Print your chart out or show it to your teacher for verification.
