

## Jersey Clicks

Jersey Clicks is a search engine that allows you to search all of the state library databases quickly and easily. The databases cover subjects such as health, history, business, education, science, current events, literature, and popular fiction.

### 1. Get Started:

Go to: Go to [www.SouthRiverLibrary.org](http://www.SouthRiverLibrary.org)  
Scroll to: Scroll to the DATABASES list on the left side of the screen  
Click: Click on JERSEY CLICKS

### 2. Begin a quick search:

Enter topic: Enter your search topic in the **QUICKSEARCH** box and click on GO.  
Enter card #: Enter the bar code from the back of your library card and click on GO.

If not satisfied with the number of resulting records ....

- Click Modify Search
- Modify your topic, select a new heading from the drop down menu, or select your database from the database groups.

### 3. Review your record results:

Display style: Select your RESULTS DISPLAY MODE from the drop down menu. Select Group by RESOURCE, or sort by TITLE, AUTHOR, or DATE.  
Manage: Select the appropriate icons to PRINT, EMAIL, or SAVE the record results for future reference.

### 4. View specific records:

Select title: Click on the title of the article (in dark blue).  
Select view: Click on HTML FULL TEXT to see the whole article or CITATION to see the citation information.  
Manage: Select the appropriate icons to PRINT, EMAIL, or SAVE the article for future reference.  
Cite: Click the ORANGE PAGE icon for citation information.  
Translate: Click on the TRANSLATE button (if available) to translate the article into one of the languages on the drop down menu.
